### As a teacher of the Haley Pilot School, I agree to:

- Adjust the curriculum to meet specific needs for instruction and make learning enjoyable.
- Collaborate with families to monitor the student's progress and figure out how to assist the student when he or she is struggling.
- Build a relationship with all the families in my class and provide families with assessments and feedback on the progress of their child.
- Send home learning tools and strategies so that parents can support the student on the subjects learned in school.
